1. The meeting was held at Valentino's Pizza in Rochester and was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by the President, Jim Ashenmacher.
2. **Jokes:**

Tim's event is on Saturday, October 7, and the Drifters are invited by Tim to use the fairgrounds on Sunday, October 8, for our event. Tim would like the Drifters to assist him during his event with parking and clean-up. If we use the same facilities, we may be able to increase our attendance numbers and draw more cars/people, which could lead to new members. We need to discuss Tim's offer and also determine the usability of the Kasson (Dodge Co.) fairgrounds and route availability in the area.
